On the other hand developers and builders also have their own grievances like struggling with several N.O.C. Clearance and facing several committees like High Rise Committee, Heritage Committee and other High Power Committee & thereby delay.

Delay involves lots of problems to Developers / Builders, like, demand in enhancement in rate by various agencies like, civil contractor, plumber, electrician, etc. further, litigation from purchase for delay in handing over possession etc.

In view of present scenario, PEATA has taken up this burning issue and planned brain storming seminar to be held on 26/04/2011.
